

## ConnAPA Support for PA Students running for AAPA Student Academy

In support of PA students and future leaders of the PA profession, the Connecticut Academy of PAs (ConnAPA) will be covering the cost of registration for PA students running for board positions at the AAPA Student Academy during the AAPA National Conference in Nashville in May 2020. This registration fee is **\$165.00**

ConnAPA will select up to 3 qualified candidates to provide financial support for their efforts in running for national leadership positions in the AAPA Student Academy.

Requirements for PA students interested in running for leadership positions in the AAPA Student Academy are as follows:

1. Candidates must be a current member of ConnAPA
2. Candidate must submit a 3 paragraph brief essay to ConnAPA on the following:
  - What is their main interest in running for a national leadership position?
  - What qualities make for a good leader?
  - What past experiences do they feel will help them as a national student leader?
  - What changes do they hope to make for students and the PA profession as a whole?
3. Candidates must attach a resume along with their essay at time of submission
